Lilongwe Water Board

Lilongwe Water Board was created in 1947 by the government of Malawi and is responsible for water supply services to the residents of Lilongwe, the Capital City of Malawi and its surrounding areas.

Lilongwe City has a population of about 1.2 million and the company serves around 83% of the population. LWB has about 79,500 metered customers and more than 1000 water Kiosks (communal water selling points) within the City.

The total pipe network for LWB is estimated at 1,843km.
