United Kingdom Pavilion

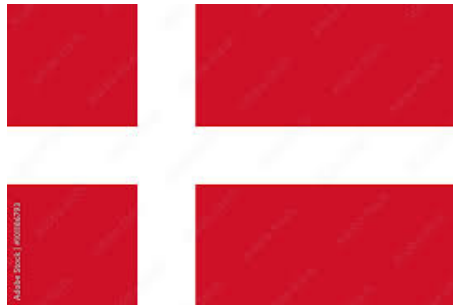

Denmark Pavilion



Participants present in the Denmark Pavilion are set to include AVK, Grundfos, Kamstrup, Unisense/Unisense Environment, DHI, DANVA, CLEAN, various universities, GTS and utilities (with various startups) as participants.

The Denmark Pavillon is being organized in a cooperation between the whole water ecosystem in Denmark, where Danish Export Association and DANVA take the lead on behalf of IWA-DK and the ecosystem brings together industry, utilities, municipalities, universities, clusters, foreign office, EPA and NGOs plus representatives from the Kingdom of Denmark.

The purpose is to go together in unison to advocate Danish answers on the world's problems with lack/loss of water, pollution, stormwater, etc. By going together, we can deliver technology, advice, demonstrations and supply policy advice on how, for example, to lower NRW to record levels. Some of our participating utilities, advisory companies, etc., also anticipate being inspired to learn from other countries.

The IWA World Water Congress & Exhibition is the only event in the world where the whole ecosystem meets to display solutions and seek ways of dealing with newly identified problems.
